The club has about 58 members, men aged 50 plus. We rent the curling facilities of the St George's Golf and Country Club at 1668 Islington Ave., Etobicoke. The club and most of its members moved to St George's when the Humber Curling Club ceased to operate in 1998. We are not members of St George's and use the old Humber name.

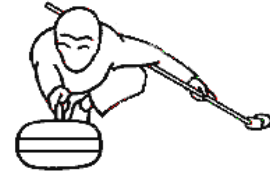
The following is a brief summary of the club's operations.

- The curling season goes from the week of October 30th thru to early April.
- There are draws, at 8:00 AM and at 10:20 AM, on Tuesdays, on Wednesdays and Fridays one draw at 9:00 AM. The draws do not happen when the ice is not available because of holidays or St George's obligations.
- These draws are scheduled in three series – Fall, Winter and Spring. Each series runs about seven weeks.
- The schedule usually leaves sheets available for open curling or practice.
- A Trophy Bonspiel will be held twice a year.
- There is afternoon curling (12:30 PM) available against various Seniors Clubs in the area, at various curling rinks. There is usually a charge of \$4.00 to \$5.00 per game.
- Come and see if you like curling, 2 training sessions are available in the fall without any cost or commitments.
