2018/19 SECOND SERIES PRIZE DETERMINATION RATIONAL

Prize Determination for each draw will be as follows:

Tuesday 8:00 am - 4 teams - every team plays the other team twice over 6 weeks. Prizes will be awarded to the 1st and 2nd place teams as described in the schedule as per the standard Humber Seniors Curling Club Rules. **Highest total points over the series** (as described in section 12 to 15 pg. 8 of this document) determines **1st and 2nd place prizes**.

Tuesday 10:20 am - 10 teams in two pools - (Teams 1-5 = Pool "A") & (Teams 6-10 = Pool "B"). Teams were randomly selected into each pool.

In this draw each team will play every other team within their pool once and one team from the other pool over a 5 week period.

1st to 5th place in each pool will be determined after the 5th week of play as per: **Highest total points over the series**.

Since there is not any regular games in week 2, 4 & 7 of this series, **the final round robin standings will be calculated at the completion of week 8**.

Teams must finish **1st, 2nd or 3rd in their Pools** in order to be **eligible for prizes in the 9th week finals**.

Week 9 will be the FINALS of Pool A versus Pool B. In the following maner:

1st to 5th place in each pool will be determined after the 5th week of play as per: Highest total points over the series.

Since there is not any regular games in week 4 of this series, **the final round robin standings will be calculated at the completion of week 6.**

There is no ice in week 7.

The finals format will be different for this series in that all the teams will have an opportunity to vie for prizes in the finals.

This draw will have 2 finals games in the last two weeks of the series. The first game will be based on "Total Points of the first finals game". Scoring will be as per the normal league scoring rules.

Wednesday, Feb. 13 2019 in Week 8 will be the first finals game of Pool A versus Pool B. In the following manner:

Please review for questions regarding legal spares, late arrivals, defaults etc.

The rules are in place for the benefit of all members and to avoid misunderstandings with regards to player responsibilities.

Please review the rules carefully and if in doubt, please consult with your skip in order to ensure that the proper number of regular players will be available for each match. Failure to do so could result in a match default for you team!

No more than 2 regular players on a team may be substituted for a given match.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

GENERAL RULES:

1. The rules and regulations of the O.C.A. except as modified to suit Humber Seniors Club operations.

2. **Eligibility** for membership – men who are at least 50 years of age, or older, or retired.

3. **Classification:**

- All members will be classified for playing positions by the Rating Committee, subject to review at the end of each series.
- All new members enter as “Lead” until rated by the Rating Committee. Any former member who has been absent for three years or more shall re-enter as “Lead” until rated.
- Requests concerning classification of any member must be in writing to the Chair of the Rating Committee. A written decision will be given by the Rating Committee.

4. **Resignations: Members who wish to resign from a team or the club should notify their skip, who will notify the Draw Committee. The Draw Committee, not the team involved, will make a replacement available to the team.**

RULES OF PLAY FOR SCHEDULED LEAGUE GAMES

5. All league games shall be eight (8) ends. Each team should ice **four** club members. At least **two must be regular members of that team. Exception:** If a team member is unable to complete a game, his team may continue with three curlers, Lead and Second positions throwing three rocks each. **If a team member is unable to complete a series, the Draw Committee shall fill that position with another appropriate player for the balance of that series.**

6. If a team member is **late for the start** of a scheduled game, the game will start on time with three players. The late arriving player will join his team at the beginning of the next end. **If a substitute player is used, and the late arriving member is not available before the completion of the 2nd end, then the late arriving member may not join the team in that game.**

7. Should no legal substitute(s) be available, a team may play with three players.

8. **No full end may be started** after 1 hour and 50 minutes from the scheduled starting time of 8:00 or 10:20. Teams are permitted to play half an end (i.e. 1 rock per curler, with a two rock free guard zone) when the end is started after 1 hour and 50 minutes but no later than 1 hour and 55 minutes from the scheduled starting time. If the end is not played, it cannot be counted on the score sheet.

9. The above rule **does not apply** to games scheduled to start at 9:00.

10. It is requested that all players adhere to [Curling Canada: Rule #7 Position of Players](#). There are provisions for a penalty for violation of any portion of this rule.

11. Substitutions in all series

- **Club members are responsible to obtain a substitute for scheduled games they can't play.**
- Players may substitute in **a position at their rated level or one level below or any level above their rating.**
- Members should first consult the list of spares for the series involved.
- All club members may be asked to substitute.
- A club member may substitute any number of times.
- The guiding principle is to try to have **full teams** and **fair play**.
- **Improper substitution shall result in application of the Default Penalty (Rule 13).**

POINT SYSTEM FOR SERIES GAMES

12. Points allotted per game:

- 10 points for a win
- 1 point for each end won
- ½ point to each team, for each end blanked, IF PLAYED
- ¼ point for counting rocks (maximum of 3 points)
- 5 points to each team, for a tied game
- Vice skips will enter the score in the scorebook, and attest to the correctness of all information recorded.

13. **Default Penalty: No points for the offending team and 18 points for the non-offending team.**

14. Average points per game will be used to determine final standings.

15. Ties in the final standings will result in any available prize money being evenly split.

The Executive reserves the right, under special circumstances, to revise the rules. Executive members may be asked to advise members regarding OCA and club regulations.
