**Gyro Charlie Bick Bonspiel Rules and Format**

- Registration opens at 8:45 a.m. Coffee and pastries will be served.
- There will be a morning game at 9:30 a.m. and an afternoon game at 1pm.
- Lunch will be served between noon and 1pm.
- Games are 7 ends only.
- Vices determine last rock using the penny wheel at each sheet.
- Usual skins format:
  - Team with hammer needs to score 2 points to win a skin, team without hammer needs only one point to win a skin
  - The team that wins the skin loses the hammer for the next end
  - If the team with hammer scores only one point, that team still loses the hammer
- Vices are to check the score cards and submit them to the draw master immediately after the game.

### **Skins Scoring**

- First end is worth one skin
- Ends 2,3,4 and 5 are worth 2 skins each
- Ends 6 and 7 are worth 3 skins each
- Team scores are the total skins won plus 10 points for the winning team

### **Bonspiel Tie-breaking Steps**

- Highest total points in both games is the overall winner. In case of a tie for **top spot**, the teams will return to the ice and each team member will throw one rock toward the glass. Sweeping your own rocks is allowed. All 4 rocks will stay on the sheet. Each team's score will be determined by a designated arbiter in accordance with a scoring sheet. The highest score will be the overall winner.
- In the event of a tie for second, third or fourth place, those teams will share the prize money, e.g. the teams tied for 2<sup>nd</sup> will share the prize money for 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup>.
